

Town of Grantsboro
Regular Meeting of Town Council
April 3, 2018

Minutes

The Grantsboro Town Council met on Tuesday, April 3, 2018 at 7:00pm in the Town Hall. Attending were: Mayor Alfred Cahoon, Mayor Pro-tem Julia Lee, Ray Poole, Tom Newman, Kristie Mitchell, and Ray Lewis, Clerk. There were three visitors present: Grantsboro residents Evelyn Paul and TW Harris; and Grantsboro Sand Mine owner Scott Cayton.

Mayor Cahoon called the meeting to order and Lewis offered the invocation. A quorum was established for the meeting. The agenda was approved upon a motion by Poole, seconded by Newman and carried. The minutes from the March meeting were approved as written upon a motion by Mitchell, seconded by Lee and carried.

Lewis presented the finance report for the month of March, which reflected \$7117.39 in revenues, and expenses of \$1666.82. Total funds were reported at \$218,549.69. A motion to approve the finance report as presented was made by Mitchell, seconded by Lee and carried.

Old Business

Scott Cayton presented the final site plans for his proposed project to build 4 “tiny homes” at 1068 Hwy 306 N, and asked the Council for approval of his zoning permit application to allow him to move forward with securing building permits and beginning construction soon. After some discussion, the plans and application were approved upon a motion by Poole, seconded by Newman and carried.

New Business

The vacancy on the Town Council created by the resignation of Pat Paul was discussed. There are currently three residents that have expressed interest in the position. It was suggested that the vacancy be posted on the Town Facebook page in case there may be additional interest in the position. A motion was made by Lee to table the matter until the May meeting, and that the vacancy be posted on the Town Facebook page. The motion was seconded by Mitchell, and carried.

Continuing financial needs for the Grantsboro /Silverhill Fire Dept. and the Pamlico County Rescue Squad were discussed. A motion to give a donation of \$1000 to the fire dept. and \$500 to the rescue squad was made by Poole, seconded by Newman and carried.

During the comment period, TW Harris and Evelyn Paul both expressed their interest in the vacant Council position, and shared some reasons why. The meeting was then adjourned upon a motion by Poole, seconded by Newman and carried.

The next meeting of the Council is scheduled for May 1, 2018.
