

Town of Grantsboro
Regular Meeting of the Town Council
August 1, 2017

Minutes

The Grantsboro Town Council met on Tuesday, August 1, 2017 at 7:00pm in the Town Hall. Attending were: Mayor Alfred Cahoon, Mayor Pro-tem Julia Lee, Ray Poole, Tom Newman, Pat Paul, and Ray Lewis, Clerk. Kristie Mitchell was absent, and there was one visitor present; Chris Schwartz of the Pamlico Co. Sheriff's Dept.

Cahoon called the meeting to order, and Lewis offered the invocation. A quorum was established for the meeting. The agenda was approved upon a motion by Newman, seconded by Poole and carried. The minutes from the July meeting were approved as written upon a motion by Lee, seconded by Newman and carried.

Lewis presented the finance report for the month of July, which reflected \$1415.66 in revenues, and expenses of \$9906.84. Total funds were reported at \$192,171.20. A motion to approve the finance report as presented was made by Paul, seconded by Lee and carried.

New Business

There was no new business on tonight's agenda

Old Business

Lewis reported that he had received email correspondence from the engineer and contractor concerning the erosion issues with the new sidewalks. The contractor plans to meet with the engineer within the next few days to develop and implement a plan to correct the problems.

Lewis reported that he had received a call from David Harris concerning the next application cycle for CDBG grants for the 306 North Sewer Extension. Mr. Harris said that he would be attending a meeting next week to get updated information, and would call back on Wednesday, August 9th to advise the Town about our prospects going forward. Mr. Harris also shared that there is a possibility that CDBG funds may be drastically reduced this year, and if they are, it would make it pretty much impossible for the Town to get awarded during this cycle.

Following a brief comment period during which some issues were shared involving solar farms within the town limits, the meeting was adjourned upon a motion by Poole, seconded by Newman and carried.

The next regular meeting of the Council is scheduled for September 5, 2017.
