Public Hearing and Regular Meeting of Town Council
August 6, 2019

Minutes

The Grantsboro Town Council met on Tuesday, August 6, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall. Attending were: Mayor Julia Lee, Mayor Pro-tem Tom Newman, Ray Poole, Kristie Mitchell, TW Harris, and Ray Lewis, Clerk. There were 3 visitors present; Paul Slabodan, Peggy Fulton, and Evelyn Paul.

Lewis offered the invocation, and Mayor Lee then opened the announced public hearing for the purpose of receiving comments concerning a proposed change to the Town Zoning Map. There were questions and comments from the three visitors present, and the questions were satisfactorily answered. Lewis shared that he had received a couple of phone calls in response to the letters that were sent to the property owners, and that their concerns and questions had been addressed satisfactorily as well, and that there were no known objections to making the change to the Zoning Map. The hearing was then closed by Lee.

Mayor Lee called the regular meeting to order. A quorum was established for the meeting. The agenda was approved upon a motion by Harris, seconded by Mitchell and carried. The minutes from the July meeting were approved as written upon a motion by Newman, seconded by Harris and carried.

Lewis presented the finance report for the month of July, which reflected \$1493.78 in revenues, and expenses of \$5701.08. Total funds were reported at \$193,381.99. A motion to approve the finance report as presented was made by Mitchell, seconded by Newman and carried.

Old Business

Kristie Mitchell had been appointed as the Town representative to the Eastern Carolina Council, but has since expressed that she would be unable to fulfill that responsibility. A motion to appoint TW Harris in her place was made by Poole, seconded by Newman and carried.

After considering the input concerning the proposed changes to the Town Zoning Map, a motion to adopt the resolution to amend the map was made by Poole, seconded by Newman and carried. A copy of the resolution is included with these minutes.

New Business

Lewis provided a copy of the quarterly report (April – June 2019) for the CDBG project to each Council member and the Mayor.

Following a brief comment period, the meeting was adjourned upon a motion by Poole, seconded by Mitchell and carried.

The next regular meeting of the Town Council is scheduled for September 3, 2019.
