

Town of Grantsboro
Regular Meeting of the Town Council
December 3, 2019

Minutes

The Grantsboro Town Council met on Tuesday, December 3, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall. Attending were: Mayor Julia Lee, Mayor Pro-tem Tom Newman, Ray Poole, Kristie Mitchell, Evelyn Paul, and Ray Lewis, Clerk. TW Harris was absent. There was 1 visitor present; Grantsboro resident Julia Isenhardt.

Mayor Lee called the meeting to order. Town Clerk Ray Lewis then administered the oath of office following the November election to Mayor Lee, Mayor Pro-tem Newman, and Council members Poole, Mitchell, and Paul. Lewis then offered the invocation, and a quorum was established for the meeting. The agenda was approved upon a motion by Mitchell, seconded by Paul and carried. The minutes from the November meeting were approved as written upon a motion by Newman, seconded by Mitchell and carried.

Lewis presented the finance report for the month of November, which reflected \$2306.56 in revenues, and expenses of \$1928.13. Total funds were reported at \$191,810.87. A motion to approve the finance report as presented was made by Poole, seconded by Newman and carried.

Old Business

There was no old business to present.

New Business

Lewis provided copies of the CDBG Project Quarterly Report for the months of July – September to the Town Council.

Lewis advised the Council that the Planning Board terms for Peggy Fulton and Tommy Spencer expire this month, and that former Planning Board member Steve Hardison had moved out of town and his spot would need to be filled. The Council will search for a new member, and consider the reappointments of Fulton and Spencer to new terms at the January 2020 meeting.

Lewis shared that pictures of Council members Paul and Harris are needed for placement in the Town Hall. Mayor Lee said she would contact Larry Prescott to see if he could do the pictures for them.

Discussion took place concerning recognition of former Mayor Alfred Cahoon. The suggestion was to provide a plaque of recognition to his wife and family, along with another plaque to be displayed in the Town Hall. The presentation will take place at the February 2020 meeting. A motion to proceed with this action was made by Newman, seconded by Mitchell and carried.

Following a brief comment period, the meeting was adjourned upon a motion by Poole, seconded by Newman and carried.

The next regular meeting of the Town Council is scheduled for January 7, 2020.
