

**Town of Grantsboro**  
**Regular Meeting of the Town Council**  
**December 7, 2021**

**Minutes**

The Grantsboro Town Council met on Tuesday, December 7, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall. Attending were: Mayor Julia Lee, Mayor Pro-tem Tom Newman, Ray Poole, TW Harris, Kristie Mitchell, Evelyn Paul, and Ray Lewis, Clerk. There were 2 visitors present.

Mayor Lee called the meeting to order, and Lewis offered the invocation. A quorum was established for the meeting. The agenda was approved upon a motion by Harris, seconded by Mitchell and carried. The minutes from the November meeting were approved upon a motion by Newman, seconded by Paul and carried.

Lewis presented the finance report for the month of November, which reflected \$5076.41 in revenues, and expenses of \$2587.77. Total funds were reported at \$245,060.60, plus \$25,837.50 in ARP Funds. A motion to approve the finance report as presented was made by Mitchell, seconded by Newman and carried.

**Old Business**

Lewis reminded the Council that a progress meeting for the CDBG Sewer System Project is scheduled for tomorrow at 1:00 pm.

Joy Hardison had been contacted concerning appointment by the Town to the CRSWMA Municipal Committee. After giving it some thought, Ms. Hardison declined. Bylon Smith, who was in attendance at tonight's meeting, was asked if she would consider serving. She agreed to give it some consideration, at let the Council know.

**New Business**

Mayor Pro-tem Newman shared a complaint concerning noise from a generator on Mill Quarter Road. It was noted that the Town does not currently have a noise ordinance.

During the public comment period, Chief Mike Grose made a few brief remarks concerning fire department activity. Bylon Smith also shared continued concerns about the tire business on Mill Quarter Rd, particularly the potential construction of a new building. The owner does not have any building or zoning permits, and Lewis will check with the County Building inspector to determine what action may be taken if work continues.

Following the comment period, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Mitchell, seconded by Newman and carried.

The next regular meeting of the Town Council is scheduled for January 4, 2022.
