

Town of Grantsboro
Regular Meeting of the Town Council
February 4, 2020

Minutes

The Grantsboro Town Council met on Tuesday, February 4, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall. Attending were: Mayor Julia Lee, Mayor Pro-tem Tom Newman, Ray Poole, Kristie Mitchell, TW Harris, Evelyn Paul, and Ray Lewis, Clerk. There were 3 visitors present.

Mayor Lee called the meeting to order, and Lewis offered the invocation. A quorum was established for the meeting. The agenda was approved upon a motion by Harris, seconded by Mitchell and carried. The minutes from the January meeting were approved as written upon a motion by Paul, seconded by Newman and carried.

Lewis presented the finance report for the month of January, which reflected \$13,625.34 in revenues, and expenses of \$4755.97. Total funds were reported at \$206,507.32. A motion to approve the finance report as presented was made by Harris, seconded by Mitchell and carried.

Old Business

Lewis shared with the Council that two matching plaques for recognition of former mayor Alfred Cahoon had been purchased. One of the plaques is on the entrance wall in the Town Hall, and the other is to be presented to Ms. Christine Cahoon. Mayor Lee shared that she had tried to contact Ms. Cahoon to see if she could be at tonight's meeting, but she was unable to reach her. Efforts will be made to schedule Ms. Cahoon's attendance at the March meeting.

The expired terms and open position on the Town Planning Board were again brought up for discussion. The terms of Peggy Fulton and Tommy Spencer have expired, and Steve Hardison has moved out of town. Two new candidates had expressed an interest in serving; Nichole Buck and Ray Dixon. After some discussion, a motion to re-appoint Tommy Spencer, and to appoint Ray Dixon and Nichole Buck to the Grantsboro Planning Board was made by Mitchell, seconded by Harris and carried.

New Business

Lewis presented a copy of the quarterly report for the CDBG-I Sewer Project for the months of Oct-Dec 2019 to the Town Council.

Lewis reported that the March meeting would need to be rescheduled due to the March 3rd Primary Elections. It was agreed to move the next month's meeting to March 10th.

Following a brief comment period, the meeting was adjourned upon a motion by Harris, seconded by Paul and carried.

The next regular meeting of the Town Council is scheduled for March 10, 2020.
