Town of Grantsboro Regular Meeting of the Town Council February 6, 2024

Minutes

The Grantsboro Town Council met on Tuesday, February 6, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall. Attending were: Mayor Tom Newman, Mayor Pro-tem Evelyn Paul, Julia Lee, Ray Poole, Kristie Mitchell, and Ray Lewis, Clerk. TW Harris was absent. There were no visitors present.

Lewis offered the invocation, and Mayor Newman called the meeting to order, and a quorum was established. The agenda for the meeting was approved upon a motion by Mitchell, seconded by Paul and carried. The minutes from the January meeting were approved upon a motion by Mitchell, seconded by Lee and carried.

Lewis presented the finance report for the month of January, which reflected \$16,965.02 in revenues, and expenses of \$12,048.13. Total funds were reported at \$281,008.36. A motion to approve the finance report as presented was made by Poole, seconded by Paul and carried.

Old Business

Lewis shared a letter for the Council to approve. The letter was in response to a minor finding on the Town's recent audit, and will be sent to the North Carolina LGC. The finding was explained by Reid Parker from CRI when he did the audit presentation at the December meeting. A motion to approve the letter was made by Lee, seconded by Paul, and carried.

New Business

Mayor Newman shared that the "Welcome to Grantsboro" sign near Keystown Road was severely faded, and that he requested DOT to replace it. They responded that they could only do a "Grantsboro City Limits" sign. Newman advised them to go ahead and do that, and to remove the old sign. There was also discussion about the possibility of putting a nice welcome sign in front of the Town Hall. Lewis will follow up on getting some ideas and estimates for a new sign.

Following a brief comment period, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Harris, seconded by Paul and carried.

The next regular meeting of the Town Council is scheduled for March 5, 2024.
