

Town of Grantsboro
Regular Meeting of the Town Council
July 11, 2017

Minutes

The Grantsboro Town Council met on Tuesday, July 11, 2017 at 7:00pm in the Town Hall. Attending were: Mayor Alfred Cahoon, Mayor Pro-tem Julia Lee, Ray Poole, Tom Newman, Pat Paul, and Ray Lewis, Clerk. Kristie Mitchell was absent.

Cahoon called the meeting to order, and Lewis offered the invocation. A quorum was established for the meeting. The agenda was approved upon a motion by Newman, seconded by Lee and carried. The minutes from the June meeting were approved as written upon a motion by Poole, seconded by Paul and carried.

Lewis presented the finance report for the month of June, which reflected \$8074.54 in revenues, and expenses of \$1956.04. Total funds were reported at \$210,452.38. A motion to approve the finance report as presented was made by Paul, seconded by Newman and carried.

New Business

There was no new business on tonight's agenda.

Old Business

Lewis reported that there are still some problem areas (erosion) with the new sidewalks on the north side of Hwy 55. Thomas Engineering is experiencing difficulty in getting Sunland Builders to correct the problems, but is still working on it. Thomas Engineering has also suggested that it may become necessary to void the contract with Sunland and secure a secondary contractor to finish the project, but they hope it doesn't come to that.

Lewis reported that all of the streetlights have been installed. The concern about the short six foot mounting arms for the lights east of Tideland have been shared with Duke Energy, and they have submitted a request to the NC DOT for approval to change them to sixteen foot arms in order to get better illumination all the way across the highway.

Following a brief comment period, the meeting was adjourned upon a motion by Poole, seconded by Newman and carried.

The next regular meeting of the Council is scheduled for August 1, 2017.
