

Town of Grantsboro
Regular Meeting of the Town Council
March 2, 2021

Minutes

The Grantsboro Town Council met on Tuesday, March 2, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall. Attending were: Mayor Julia Lee, Mayor Pro-tem Tom Newman, Ray Poole, TW Harris, Evelyn Paul, and Ray Lewis, Clerk. Kristie Mitchell was absent. There was 1 visitor present.

Mayor Lee called the meeting to order, and Lewis offered the invocation. A quorum was established for the meeting. The agenda was approved upon a motion by Newman, seconded by Harris and carried. The minutes from the February meeting were approved upon a motion by Harris, seconded by Newman and carried.

Lewis presented the finance report for the month of February, which reflected \$19,825.82 in revenues, and expenses of \$2331.37. Total funds were reported at \$230,877.84. A motion to approve the finance report as presented was made by Paul, seconded by Harris and carried.

Old Business

David Harris with RSM Harris Associates was present to share updates on the Hwy 306 N CDBG Sewer Project. Work continues to progress, and the contractor has begun setting tanks. The Council talked with Harris about income limits, and about not being aware of all the requirements to get connected. Harris shared that some of the low income qualifying persons now did not qualify, and would not be getting hooked up. This will open the possibility for others to get service that are above the income level, although they will have to pay for electrical to the control panel, and plumbing connection to the tank. The goal is to get at least 25 to 30 houses connected.

Town Clerk Lewis had advised the Council prior that the copier in the Town Hall office was no longer eligible to be under service contract due to its age, but we would continue to use it as long as it was working properly. There is now an issue with the machine, and Lewis asked about getting a quote for a new copier similar to the one we have. The Council agreed, and hopefully we will have that information for the April meeting.

New Business

Lewis shared the 4 lowest bids that had been received for providing mowing services for the Town. After some discussion, the contract for mowing services was awarded to C & R Lawn & Landscaping.

Following a brief comment period, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Harris, seconded by Newman and carried.

The next regular meeting of the Town Council is scheduled for April 6, 2021.
