Resolution No. 04-05-16

A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANTSBORO, NC
TO HOLD A MIXED BEVERAGE ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Grantsboro Town Council has determined that the registered voters of the Town of Grantsboro should be given an opportunity to determine whether mixed beverages should be sold for consumption within the corporate limits of Grantsboro; and


WHEREAS, the Grantsboro Town Council did vote: 4 "for" and 0 "against" during its April 5, 2016 meeting to hold a Mixed Beverage Election on the 8th day of November, 2016 to allow the citizens of Grantsboro to determine the issue of the sale of mixed beverages within Grantsboro; and

WHEREAS, NC General Statute 18b-600 does give the Town of Grantsboro authorization to hold a Mixed Beverage Election.

THEREFORE, THE TOWN OF GRANTSBORO TOWN COUNCIL RESOLVES THAT:


1. The registered voters of the Town of Grantsboro should be given the opportunity to determine whether mixed beverages should be sold for consumption within the corporate limits of Grantsboro.
2. If necessary, the Town Attorney shall forward to the U.S. Department of Justice a written request for preclearance so that the Pamlico County Board of Elections may place the mixed beverage proposal on the General Election ballot for the 8th of November 2016.
3. Mayor Alfred E. Cahoon is authorized to execute this Resolution and any written request to call for said election on behalf of the Town of Grantsboro.
