

Town of Grantsboro
Regular Meeting of the Town Council
October 3, 2023

Minutes

The Grantsboro Town Council met on Tuesday, October 3, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall. Attending were: Mayor Pro-tem Tom Newman, Ray Poole, TW Harris, Kristie Mitchell, Evelyn Paul, and Ray Lewis, Clerk. Mayor Julia Lee was absent. There was one visitor present.

Lewis offered the invocation, and Mayor Pro-tem Newman called the meeting to order. A quorum was established. The agenda for the meeting was approved upon a motion by Mitchell, seconded by Harris and carried. The minutes from the September meeting were approved upon a motion by Harris, seconded by Paul and carried.

Lewis presented the finance report for the month of August, which reflected \$3318.97 in revenues, and expenses of \$4577.91. Total funds were reported at \$268,079.41. Lewis also presented the finance report for the month of September, which reflected \$8736.47 in revenues, and expenses of \$2206.46. Total funds were reported at \$275,133.18. A motion to approve both finance reports as presented was made by Poole, seconded by Mitchell and carried.

Old Business

Newman shared with the Council that Cody Paul had not been paid anything by Jones & Smith Contractors for being allowed to use his property as a staging area during the recent sewer system expansion.

Lewis shared with the Council that two of the driveways at the new Motion Church location would be closed off per their DOT driveway permit.

New Business

Newman expressed some concern about grass growing in the joints and along the edges of the sidewalk on the south side of Hy 55 between Tideland and Pamlico Pharmacy. Lewis will share the concerns with Curtis Tillman.

During the public comment period, Fire Chief Mike Grose shared that the Grantsboro/Silverhill station had purchased a new to them fire truck from the city of Garner. The truck is a 2007 model, and the purchase was made possible due to the recent donation from the Town of Grantsboro.

Following the comment period, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Harris, seconded by Mitchell and carried.

The next regular meeting of the Town Council is scheduled for November 14, 2023. (this is a week later than usual due to elections on the 7th.)
