

Town of Grantsboro Planning Board

Regular Meeting on April 28, 2016

Minutes

The Grantsboro Planning Board met on April 28, 2016. Attending were: Peggy Padrick, Chair; Vannah Holton, Vice-Chair; board members Steve Hardison, Tommy Spencer, and Stephen Lane; and town clerk Ray Lewis.

Padrick called the meeting to order, and Lewis offered the invocation. A quorum was present. The agenda was approved upon a motion by Hardison, seconded by Spencer and carried. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved as written upon a motion by Holton, seconded by Lane and carried.

Lewis informed the Planning Board that the Town Council was going to consider a pet/animal ordinance, and would like to get the opinion of the Planning Board. Padrick, Lane, and Spencer were all opposed to the idea, and Hardison and Holton would like more information before making a final decision.

Lewis shared that the Council had discussed the possibility of the Town moving forward with extending the sidewalks east of the intersection. The options discussed were to do the north side between the two ditch lines (which would not require curbing), or to do the south side with curbing. The preferred option of the Planning Board was to do the south side (unanimous).

Lewis gave updates that the street light project was still moving along; and that the Nova office building and the new retail seafood market (old Hospice location) should be completed soon.

After a brief comment period, the meeting was adjourned upon a motion by Spencer, seconded by Lane and carried.

The next Planning Board meeting is scheduled for July 21.
