

**Town of Grantsboro  
Regular Meeting of Town Council  
September 6, 2016**

**Minutes**

The Grantsboro Town Council met on Tuesday, September 6, 2016 at 7:00pm in the town hall. Attending were: Mayor Alfred Cahoon, Mayor Pro-tem Julia Lee, Ray Poole, Kristie Mitchell, Pat Paul, and Ray Lewis, Clerk. Tom Newman was absent. There were two visitors present; Zach and Amanda Heath from the Grantsboro-Silverhill VFD.

Cahoon called the meeting to order, and Lewis offered the invocation. A quorum was established for the meeting, and the agenda was approved upon a motion by Poole, seconded by Mitchell and carried. The minutes from the August meeting were approved as written upon a motion by Paul, seconded by Mitchell and carried.

Lewis presented the finance report for the month of August, which reflected \$1871.09 in revenues, and expenses of \$9215.19. Total funds were reported at \$252,787.34. A motion to approve the finance report as presented was made by Poole, seconded by Mitchell and carried.

**Old Business**

Lewis reported that there was no new information to share since the last meeting concerning the street lights or the sidewalks.

Lewis reminded the Council that a new date for ethics training needed to be set. September 29<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm was decided upon.

**New Business**

Zach and Amanda Heath were present at the meeting tonight to give a presentation concerning the new equipment that the Grantsboro-Silverhill VFD was able to purchase with the help of the recent donation that was made by the town. A new turnout gear set was demonstrated by Zach, and Amanda shared a list of several other items that were purchased, along with an explanation of how they will help the department. The Council thanked them for the update, and their work in the Town and surrounding areas.

Lewis reported to the Council that David Harris with RSM Harris Associates had requested that the Council set a date for a public hearing for the CDBG Grant application for the proposed sewer line extension along Hwy 306N. It was decided to schedule the hearing on

Monday, September 26 at 7:00pm upon a motion by Lee, seconded by Paul and carried. The hearing will be held at the town hall.

After a brief comment period, the meeting was adjourned upon a motion by Poole, seconded by Mitchell and carried.

The next regular meeting is scheduled for October 4, 2016 at 7:00pm.
