Town of Grantsboro Regular Meeting of the Town Council September 5, 2023

Minutes

The Grantsboro Town Council met on Tuesday, September 5, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall. Attending were: Mayor Pro-tem Tom Newman, Ray Poole, TW Harris, Evelyn Paul, and Ray Lewis, Clerk. Mayor Julia Lee and Kristie Mitchell were absent. There was one visitor present.

Lewis offered the invocation, and Mayor Pro-tem Newman called the meeting to order. A quorum was established. The agenda for the meeting was approved upon a motion by Harris, seconded by Paul and carried. The minutes from the July regular meeting and the called August meeting were approved upon a motion by Harris, seconded by Paul and carried. There was no regular meeting in August due to lack of a quorum.

Lewis presented the finance report for the month of July, which reflected \$53,494.94 in revenues, and expenses of \$60,013.08. Total funds were reported at \$299,405.61. \$51,675.00 of the revenue amount is from ARP Funds. A motion to approve the finance report as presented was made by Harris, seconded by Paul and carried. The August report has not yet been prepared.

New Business

Mayor Pro-tem Newman gave a report from the last mayor's meeting in July.

Lewis reported that the grant applications for the proposed apartments in Grantsboro were submitted by the August 25th deadline. A decision on the awards is expected sometime in late October.

Information was shared concerning required Treasury training for all candidates for Town Council in the upcoming November election. Only Newman and Paul have completed the training so far. Harris acknowledged that he would try and help the others get it completed.

Newman shared that there had been some communication from the County offices concerning the possibility of relocating the Reelsboro recycling station to the back area of the Town Hall parking lot. No formal request has been made, but the Council expressed reservations and did not think that would be a good idea.

Lewis shared that two CD's at United Bank would be maturing on September 11. Lewis suggested that the two CD's be combined into one and renewed at the best rate. A motion to approve was made by Paul, seconded by Harris and carried.

Following a brief comment period, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Harris, seconded by Paul and carried.

The next regular meeting of the Town Council is scheduled for October 3, 2023.
