

Town of Grantsboro
Regular Meeting of the Town Council
December 3, 2024

Minutes

The Grantsboro Town Council met on Tuesday, December 3, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall. Attending were: Mayor Tom Newman, Mayor Pro-tem Evelyn Paul, Julia Lee, Ray Poole, TW Harris, Kristie Mitchell, and Ray Lewis, Clerk. There were no visitors.

Lewis offered the invocation, and Mayor Newman called the meeting to order. A quorum was established, and the agenda for the meeting was approved upon a motion by Harris, seconded by Paul and carried. The minutes from the November meeting were approved upon a motion by Harris, seconded by Mitchell and carried.

Lewis presented the finance report for the month of November, which reflected \$3926.61 in revenues, and expenses of \$6013.91. Total funds were reported at \$274,876.53. A motion to approve the finance report as presented was made by Mitchell, seconded by Poole and carried.

Old Business

Harris shared with the Council that he had sent an email to Jim Evans with NC DOT. Harris shared concerns about the 55/306 intersection, and concerns about the Walmart entrance. There has not yet been a response.

Lewis shared with the Council that the state legislature is working to get the funding in place for the proposed new apartments, and hopefully the contract will be approved soon by the County Commissioners.

Lewis shared that he had reached out to Daniel Hacker with Ditch Doctor to see if some of the ditches in the Town could either be eliminated or redesigned to make them easier to maintain.

New Business

Lewis shared a copy of a proposed resolution prohibiting viewing of pornographic material on Town networks and devices. Town Attorney David Baxter drafted the resolution, which is required by state statutes by January 1, 2025. A motion to adopt the resolution was made by Harris, seconded by Paul and carried.

Following a brief comment period, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Mitchell, seconded by Paul and carried.

The next regular meeting of the Town Council is scheduled for January 7, 2025.
